INSTALLATION

Please make sure that the set delivered to you contains all the elements, that is:

- fireplace (housing)
- hearth (steel rectangular tank)
- glass and steel mountings for glass panel
- steel long handle for adjusting and extinguishing a flame
 - 1. Choose the room in which you want to use the fireplace. The room in which the device will be used should have a minimum area of 20m2.
 - 2. When using the fireplace in a room, the window must be tilted.
 - 3. The room in which the fireplace is used should always be ventilated, as it absorbs oxygen from the air. Do not install the fireplace in a place where it will be exposed to draught!
 - 4. The fireplace should be placed on an even and stable surface, in a place where it will not be exposed to falling over, should stick backwards to the wall.
 - 5. The wall behind the fireplace must not be covered with any combustible material.
 - 6. Place the rectangular steel tank (the hearth) in the rectangular opening inside the fireplace.
 - 7. Insert the glass into the mountings and tighten it from the back using a screwdriver.
 - 8. Fix the fireplace to the wall using the supplied screws by screwing it to the wall and attaching the fireplace with the "ears" at the back of the fireplace.
 - 9. Do not place any objects on the housing or inside the fireplace.
 - 10. Do not place any flammable materials in a distance of at least 2 m from the device.
